

Ephesians Seminar

November 13-15, 2015

John and Gervais Crouch join us for a weekend of great Bible teaching and sweet fellowship with the saints!

John is a long-time researcher and workman of the Word, and he'll be guiding us as we dig deep into the truths of the New Testament book of Ephesians.

At times God uses figurative language in His Word—figures of speech—to add special emphasis to what He is saying. This seminar will explore these figures, to consider how they add a Godly-designed emphasis in the context in which they occur.

We'll be looking at Ephesians because of its important theme of the "mystery," a secret that God had held since the beginning of time until He revealed it to the apostle Paul, who wrote it in this epistle.

Because the Bible has one Author, we should expect consistency in its wording, and in its figurative language. We'll compare the figures of speech in Ephesians with the same occurrences in other Scriptures, showing their consistency and how the special revelation of Ephesians augments its own figurative language.

We'll see that God has a purpose for everything He says—where He says it, why He says, how He says it, when He says it, to whom He says it!

Even for Christians who have read this epistle dozens of times, this presentation promises to give new insight, not only in our understanding of the epistle, but in practical suggestions on how the order of the text displays a plan of action for our day-by-day living.
