I thought I was better than many pastors from the entire coastal region because I had gone to a better Baptist bible college and I had a good Christian background. In the first years we had over 600 people coming to our church. Everything seemed well until we started having disagreements in our leadership. The numbers fell down to less than 40 members, and each time there was a disagreement the church split. This continued on and off until I was almost giving up.

> One day one of my friends introduced me to Kingdom Faith Ministries International School of Ministry in Mombasa. I learned how to wait upon the Lord in His secret place, and how to dine at the Master's table. These took me back to God. I started making



warfare as the Holy Sprit led me to pray for the entire area. I didn't know that the forces that were against the church were (from) the Muslim community who practiced witchcraft. They had made the area hard for the Gospel to penetrate. I was teaching people theology but not the Rhema word from God. When I started practicing your teaching my church started growing. We have grown from 40 to 356 members in two years.

Wisdom we have learned to help equip pastors and church leaders:

- Enjoy the anointing, but Seek The Anointed One, Jesus Christ. Drawing near to Him enables greater spiritual authority in ministering to others. Jesus Christ is the head. We study to preach His written Word, and to let His Word abide in us.
- The message is greater than the messenger. Jesus made Himself of no reputation. We refuse to allow others to give us one through titles, selfpromotion, etc.
- Teach just as passionately to five as to 5,000.
 We are not looking for numbers. We are looking for the next Apostle Paul, Peter, and John.
- We are not a denomination. We do not encourage obligation/idol-forming spiritual partnerships, memberships, affiliations, etc. Instead, we mentor and teach those who will be faithful to teach others also. Our only desire is to please the Lord and give to other pastors what the Holy Spirit has given to us:
 - Spirit-filled teaching in how to hear and obey the voice of the Lord Jesus Christ and our Heavenly Father with confidence, clarity, and precision.
 - Understanding in how to effectively operate in spiritual warfare including breaking curses, severing ungodly soul ties, neutralizing witch-craft, healing the sick, and casting out demons.
 - Wisdom to teach how to operate all nine manifestations of the Holy Spirit for effective ministry including gifts of healings, and speaking in tongues.
- ◊ Effective discipleship happens when students learn to hear & obey the Lord's voice for themselves. Letting His *rhema*-speaking words abide in us is all about learning what He is speaking to us today, and gathering it as manna for building a church against which the gates of hell shall not prevail.
